## LIST OF RESIDENTIAL UNITS CLASSIFIED INTO INSTITUTIONAL SECTORS

Agency for Statistics of Bosnia and Herzegovina, in cooperation with the Federal Office for Statistics of Bosnia and Herzegovina and Republic Srpska Institute for Statistics publishes a list of **resident** units

(business entities) classified into institutional sectors (S.1). The list does not include non-resident units that belong to the foreign sector (S.2).

The list was prepared in line with internationally accepted standards (European system of national and regional accounts - ESA 2010, Manual on Government deficit and debt - MGDD), and the Decision on statistical classification of institutional sectors (Official Gazette of BiH, number 19/17).

The list was compiled on the basis of information available in the Statistical Business Register, as of 31.12.2021/31.12.2022 as well as other information collected through regular statistical surveys. Although statistical institutions are continuously working on improving the quality of available sources, as well as their availability, due to the current limited information, there may be inconsistencies in the assigned sector code and the actual state in business entity.

Therefore, the List is published as **temporary**, and provides the opportunity for the units, which are on it, to attach of additional information request a change in the sector code.

The purpose of the list of units classified into institutional sectors is exclusively statistical, that is, creation assumptions for the development of Sector Accounts, Government Finance Statistics, and other related statistics, in line with the methodological framework.
