# STATISTIKA OBRAZOVANJA

## *Education Statistics*

### **Predškolsko obrazovanje**

U školskoj 2012/2013. godini u BiH ukupno je bilo 243 predškolske ustanove sa 18.817 djece. U odnosu na prethodnu školsku godinu broj predškolskih ustanova je veći za 8,9 %, broj djece korisnika predškolskih ustanova porastao je za 8,8 %, a broj zaposlenih veći je za 4,3 %.

### **Osnovno obrazovanje**

Na početku školske 2012/2013. godine u BiH u 1.883 osnovne škole upisano je 304.972 učenika, što je u odnosu na prethodnu školsku godinu manje za 11.685 učenika, ili 3,7 %.

Na početku školske 2012/2013. godine u nastavni proces bilo je uključeno 24.484 nastavnika, a od toga 17.089 žena ili 69,8 %.

### **Srednje obrazovanje**

Na početku školske 2012/2013. godine u BiH u 313 srednjih škola upisano je 166.122 učenika, što je u odnosu na prethodnu školsku godinu više za 2.838 učenika, ili 1,7 %. Na početku školske 2012/2013. godine u nastavni proces bilo je uključeno 13.045 nastavnika, a od toga 7.643 žene ili 58,6 %.

### **Visoko obrazovanje**

U školskoj 2012/2013. godini u zimski semester (stari program i Bolonjski program: 1. ciklus i integrirani 1. i 2. ciklus) upisano je 111.931 student, od toga je 102.357 studenata upisano na sve godine studija, a 9.574 su apsolvanti. U 2012. godini diplomiralo je 18.279 studenata, što je za 2,5 % više u odnosu na školsku 2011. godinu. Od ukupnog broja diplomiranih studenata 60,4 % su studentice.

### **Pre-school education**

*In 2012/2013 school year, in the territory of BiH, were 243 pre-school institutions with 18.817 children. Compared to the previous school year, the number of pre-school institutions is 8,9 % higher, the number of children in pre-school institutions increased by 8,8 %, and the number of employees is 4,3 % higher.*

### **Basic schools**

*At the beginning of the school year 2012/2013, in the territory of BiH, were 304.972 pupils enrolled in 1.883 schools, which was 11.685 pupils less or 3,7 % lower in comparison with the previous year. At the beginning of the school year 2012/2013, there were 24.484 teachers included in the education process out of which 17.089 or 69,8 % women.*

### **Secondary schools**

*At the beginning of the school year 2012/2013, in the territory of BiH, were 166.122 pupils enrolled in 313 schools, which was 2.838 pupils more or 1,7 % higher pupils in comparison with the previous year. At the beginning of the school year 2012/2013, there were 13.045 teachers included in the education process, out of which 7.643 or 58,6 % were women.*

### **Higher education**

*In the winter semester of the academic year 2012/2013, 111.931 students were enrolled (Old program and Bologna-compliant program: first cycle and integrated I and II cycle), out of which 102.357 students were enrolled in all study years, while 9.574 were candidates for graduation. In 2012 there were 18.279 students who graduated, which was 2,5 % higher in comparison with the previous year. Out of the total number of graduated students, 60,4 % were female.*
